I climbed every hill, spent whole days exploring the area by bike (only returning home for my tea), and spent an enormous amount of time playing in Sutton Park. If my memory serves me correctly then the slide that was there when I was young must have been at least 20 feet tall and you climbed up the small steps to the top holding onto some very low handrails. Sutton Park was opened in 1912 and was created from land bequeathed by John William Hartley of Sutton Hall and James Bairstow of Springfield. Both of them were owners of the large mills in Sutton of which only one still exists today, albeit as

apartments. Springfield was a large house at the Eastburn end of Sutton Lane, where



only the lodge still remains. Sutton Hall was on the way up to the Clough.

Anyway, back to Sutton Park which, in these days of largely indoor screen based entertainment, still commands an impressive pull for the good people of Sutton. During these long summer days the paddling pool is always impressively attended and still filled with water from Sutton Beck by means of magical gates

and pulley systems. There is the Bowlina Green. the Pitch and Putt. the Multi Sports Area and the shelters. Shelters which have witnessed generations of Suttoners passing the time of day, gossiping, complaining, sharing secrets and making plans for adventures. It is refreshing to find that some things remain constant from one generation to the next.

So it's there if you want



Brontë Parsonage Museum at 90 A History of the Museum in 10 Objects

The Museum's

Jewellery Collection

This is cheating a bit, because it's not just one object: the Brontë Parsonage Museum holds almost a hundred jewellery items associated with the Brontë family. At first glance, it is a collection typical of women of their circumstances: as the daughters of a Victorian clergyman, it would not have been expected that the three young women would have worn expensive jewellery. There are many items of mourning jewellery made from the hair of lost loved ones, including Emily, a trend

which was very popular during the 1840s and 1850s when Charlotte, with her new-found wealth, could have afforded to commission pieces made fro the hair of her sisters.

However, there are also some very unusual pieces for a

family of their circumstances. There is the beautiful necklace of carnelian beads which it is suggested is worn by Anne Brontë in Charlotte's 1834 portrait of her sister. There are a number of rings of different styles: set with pearls, rubies, diamonds and turquoise, stamped with emblems, a looped band giving the suggestion of infinity. There are brooches but also agate stones of a similar size, suggesting that these were intended to be fixed into a brooch setting as soon as an appropriate jeweller could be found. Alongside these beautiful items, there are also more eccentric pieces: a length of seashells and transparent glass beads, giving the appearance of a necklace but with no clasp or visible way of attaching the item around the neck.

The questions that this collection prompt are: how did this family come to have these items? Who would have worn them and how? Where were they created? Although the Museum can be sure of the provenance of the majority of these collection items, some are

> tion very early acquisitions. The early curators do not appear to have dug deeply into provenance details (in one case, all we know about where the items came from is that they were given by 'an old lady from Hull' who was said to have nursed Charlotte Brontë prior to her death). However, the items themselves give clues as

to lifestyles of the Brontë family and their relationships with jewellery and fashion, and as such, they are a highly important part of the collection.



Voice assistants are everywhere these days, in our phones, our tablets, our computers, our smart speakers, our refrigerators, you name it. Gimmicky? Perhaps, but there's no denying that they've exploded in popularity. So what is a voice-assistant exactly, and what can it do for you?

A voice assistant is a digital assistant that uses voice recognition, natural language processing, and speech synthesis to provide aid to users through voice recognition applications. These

voice assistants are built on artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning and voice recognition technology. Artificial intelligence such as voice assistants might seem gimmicky right now, but I wholeheartedly believe that they are the future of a smart home, and it's not hard to see why.


