Ofsted rate Oxenhope preschool as "good" and give special praise to the commitment of the staff, commenting that

the children make good progress as they engage in purposeful learning experiences.

Oxenhope pre-school was established in 1960 by a group of local mums who recognised the need for a toddler and pre-school provision in the area for their children.

Oxenhope pre-school is a nonprofit making, charitable organisation which is run by qualified and caring staff and a volunteer committee. The committee is an essential part of the preschool as it cannot run without one and new members are always welcome.

The pre-school provides a fun; caring environment for pre-school children aged between 2 and 4, and has good links with the local primary school making transition to school as smooth as possible. We



are planning to hold an extra session from 12pm-3pm on a Tuesday afternoon allowing children to either stay with us from 9am or just join us for the afternoon. Did you know we offer free places for some eligible 2 vear olds? Research

has shown that access to quality early education improves children's outcomes. Some two year olds are entitled to free early education if they meet certain eligibility criteria. The government will fund up to 570 hours of free childcare for each eligible child. This means that your child may be able to access up to 15 hours per week of free childcare during term at our setting.

They can do less hours if you prefer. You may be eligible if you receive

certain benefits or if they are a looked after child.

> for a funded place they can still attend pre school as a fee payer from the age of 2 and a half. Current prices are £11 per session (3 hours). All 3 and 4 year old children are entitled to up to

15 free hours per week from the term after their third birthday.

friendly butcher stacking freshly made pies in his display case; the smell of golden warm pastry is a joy to my senses and I make a mental note to return for a taste. We linked up with a local charity there called

'L'auberge Des Migrants International' and it was

encouraging to see the volunteer work already

people who had committed months of their time

to help the refugees. However it was guite easy

going on there through the organisation, and

I moved up to Haworth a few months ago to start training as a Minister at West Lane Baptist Church. Since then I've been involved in a number of different church and community initiatives, a key one is helping with the refugee crisis in Calais.

It's been amazing to see the response of the people in the Worth Valley. Many have come

together to raise money and make donations of food and clothing for the refugees.

Last month I made a journey down to Calais along with Martin and Luke who head up the charity Fresh Waters in Keighley. Martin had access to a van through the charity, and we spent a number of weeks collecting, raising money, and sorting donations of different

items including tents and sleeping bags to take to Calais.

Once we had stocked the van we made the 300 mile journey via the ferry. When we entered the camp it was instantly clear how great a need there is there, as there's approximately 7000 refugees camping in awful conditions. It is mostly young men in the camp from numerous different countries affected by war and poverty, however there was also a large women's section to feel overwhelmed by the scale of people living on that wasteland. They estimate around 100 refugees are arriving every week, with no sign of them being allowed into the UK, or being given proper housing in France. None the less it was still encouraging to see the small but instant impact we had by providing the items we brought to the charity, and helping distribute coats to the

refugees. It's opened my eyes to the need, and I look forward to exploring what more we as a church and community can do to help our fellow human beings.

A massive thank you to all who contributed in the lead up to the trip. We were overwhelmed by the donations of items - we couldn't fit them all in the van! Martin is considering another trip to Calais and we are also exploring other ways of helping the refugees as some get placed in the Bradford area - so watch this space!
