



Haworth's famous pub, The Black Bull, now under new management, is raising the bar.

"Getting the beer right was the first thing we looked at." said landlord Jim Winchester. "People expect real ale and quality is key. We think we've got that right," he asserted.

"Secondly, the food has to be good home cooked pub fare offering traditional choices like Yorkshire pudding, Fish and Chips,

Sausage and Mash. It has taken a little longer than we expected but we have invested heavily in getting the kitchen up to speed and we are now serving food daily from noon until 6pm with a 2 meals for £10 deal. We hope that demonstrates our commitment to offering our customers real value. We also want to give people an incentive to come in to the pub and give us a try."

Another focus is on music. With live entertainment three nights a week, The Black Bull is pulling in musical talent from across the region.



The poppy has a long association with Remembrance Day. But how did the distinctive red flower become

such a potent symbol of our remembrance of the sacrifices made in past wars?

Scarlet corn poppies (popaver rhoeas) grow naturally in conditions of disturbed earth throughout Western Europe. The destruction brought by the Napoleonic wars of the early 19th Century transformed bare land into fields of blood red poppies, growing around the bodies of the fallen soldiers.

In late 1914, the fields of Northern France and Flanders were once again ripped open as World War One raged through Europe's heart. Once the conflict was over the poppy was one of the only plants to grow on the otherwise barren battlefields.

The significance of the poppy as a lasting memorial symbol to the fallen was realised by the Canadian surgeon John McCrae in his poem In Flanders Fields. The poppy came to represent the immeasurable sacrifice made by his comrades and quickly became a lasting memorial to those who died in World War One and later conflicts. It was adopted by The Royal British Legion as the symbol for their Poppy Appeal, in aid of those serving in the British Armed Forces, after its formation in 1921.



This cake benefits greatly for being wrapped tightly and left to mature for a few days making it sticky and chewy so please be patient with it! Ingredients 100 grams golden syrup 25 grams black treacle 75 grams butter 75 grams soft brown sugar 175 grams porridge oats 75 grams self-rising flour 1 1/2 teaspoons ground ginger 1 pinch of salt 1 egg (small, begten)

1 tablespoon of milk

1 Pre- heat the oven to gas mark 1, 275F or 140C. Grease and line a loaf tin.

2 First weigh a saucepan on the scales and then weigh in it the syrup, treacle, sugar and butter, place over a gentle heat and let the butter melt, don't let it boil.

3 Meanwhile in a bowl put the flour, porridge oats, salt and ginger. Once the syrup mixture has melted stir into the dry ingredients. Once combined add the egg and milk.

4 Pour into the tin and cook for about an hour in the middle of the oven, or until the centre feels springy to the touch.

5 Let it cool for 30 mins in the tin before turning it out and allowing to cool fully before wrapping and maturing it. Enjoy.

Just a note on the oatmeal: if you can't find medium oatmeal buy porridge oats and blitz them for a few seconds in a food processor; do not over-do this, you want rough crumbs, not dust.



November always feels a bit like the lull before the festive storm. Santa is finalising his preparations, and his Pixies are busily wrapping gifts ready for the Santa Special trains that run every weekend in December. They are very popular and some trains are already full, so please do book soon on www.kwvr.co.uk to avoid any disappointment.

So what will 2015 hold for the Railway? After a busy programme of events in 2014 and a lot of work behind the scenes, we have a number of projects in the advanced stage of development. We hope to secure funding for the cafe at Oxenhope, which will provide our long-overdue catering facility and we also hope to start work on refurbishing the interior of the Keighley Water Tower building, which we hope to develop into a visitor centre, managed by our Young Person's Group (YPG).

The YPG warrants mention in itself: this is a carefully-supervised group for 13-15 year old volunteers, which prepares them for joining as an adult volunteer in a variety of roles, including 'permanent way' (maintaining the track), the locomotive and rolling stock departments

(repairing as well as helping to crew the engine when old enough), stations duties, catering and tour guiding. Our challenge is to make sure that we pass the knowledge and experience down through the generations to ensure we have the expertise in future decades. With this in mind, we intend to refurbish our engineering and storage areas at Haworth, which will give us a

better training facility, and also give us a better viewing area for visitors, who currently get to see very little of the magic that happens in Haworth shed, where our volunteers breathe life back into 100+ year old steam locomotives, and have done since the first steam locomotive

arrived on the line 50 years ago in January 2015. Next year will be a very important one, as we see the fruits of our planning labours, but also as we mark this 50th anniversary of the first 'working' members, who are the ones

that work tirelessly to make all that you see happen. I do hope that you will consider joining us, whether you can offer just a few hours a month or are looking for a (semi-)retirement project, and whatever your area of interest!


