WINED & DINED

BY CLAIRE SMITH

Claire Smith from No. 10 The Coffee House in Haworth delights us with her unique culinary inspirations.

"Season of mist and mellow fruitfulness, close bosom friend of the maturing sun; conspiring with him to load and bless with fruit the vines that round the thatch-eves run."

Autumn, the space between summer and winter, warmth and chill, when the earth breathes with contented fulfilment and the last oozing drops of its ripening. A fruit-laden pause before slumber.

This is a time to celebrate the harvest of a fertile earth, still swelling in the September sun; the principal time in the alchemic culinary calendar for gathering and preserving the essence of summertime. The art of jam making, which began in the Middle East and was brought to Europe by the crusaders, is enjoying something of a revival in a society rebelling against mass produced, chemically enhanced food. Shelves filled with jars containing jewel coloured jams, jellies and preserves are evocative of blue skies and hazy summer days, and are capable of bringing immense satisfaction to their creators when spread on thickly cut buttered toast and eaten in front of a cosy fire in the winter months- definitely a fair exchange for the trouble it takes to prepare them.

I love cherries preserved in Armagnac (you can use any brandy as long as the

quality is good); the longer you keep them the nicer they are and the liqueur in which they reside become, and certain members of my family cannot face breakfast without the exquisite flavours delivered by the clementine and cranberry marmalade brought to us by our friend Annette when she visits. These bottled treasures, the culmination of natural and human artistry also make the most wonderful and welcome gifts.

Autumn is the season for preserving peaches, blackberries, black and gold plums, bilberries, raspberries and tomatoes. Using fruit which is plump and ready for eating but not over-ripe will produce the best results; peaches,



raspberries and strawberries should be slightly under-ripe. The quality of the sugar used also forms an essential element in jam-

making, preserving sugar being the best choice. Too little sugar will cause the jam to ferment; too much will make it over concentrated and cause it to crystallise. You can further enhance the flavour of your jam by adding a little vanilla or cinnamon, alcohol such as rum or kirsch or by combining fruits- blackberry and apple for example. When it comes to using tomatoes, tomato preserve made using tomatoes, sugar, water and vanilla results in a preserve of the most beautiful and delicate flavour, and tomato honey, which originates from America, is excellent with hot and cold meats.

So gather up all that nature has to offer and enjoy the flavours of summer all year round.


"What are you supposed to use for writing boy?"







GARDENER'S TIPS

BY MIKE CUNNINGHAM

Mike Cunningham, Chair of Keighley in Bloom and co-organiser of Keighley Horticultural Show, shares his tips for September.

SEPTEMBER

This is the month when the garden seems to glow with colour; the month where fruit begins to ripen, Dahlias, and Chrysanthemums come into full bloom; where the shortening days and the first early morning frosts give us a foretaste of autumn.

Roses:

Continue spraying to protect against both black spot and mildew. To harden new shoots apply a feed of sulphate of potash. Remove all small buds that are unlikely to open before the early frosts begin. Shorten long shoots to protect against autumn gales. Continue deadheading. Tie in new shoots on climbers. Now is a good time to prepare a new rose bed by digging well and adding plenty of well-rotted manure.

Lawns:

Continue to mow, but the blades should be raised to give a lighter cut. Scarify or rake the lawn vigorously in two directions to remove debris and open up the turf surface ready for application of an autumn fertiliser. New turf can be laid this month.

Flowering Plants:

Carry on deadheading fading flowers and cutting back unsightly perennials to few inches above ground level, but remember to save and dry seed heads for next year. Hoe previously prepared beds and

borders. At end of month start to clear summer bedding plants.

Bulbs:

Plant spring flowering bulbs, but not tulips. I always use new bulb-fibre for bulbs planted in bowls etc. Sow or plant out hardy annuals such as candytuft, larkspur, love-in-the-mist and poppies etc. Plant indoor flowering bulbs for Christmas such as hyacinths.

Vegetables:

Gather unharvested produce before it is damaged by frost or starts rotting in the ground. Remove potato plants infected by blight and burn them. Plant out spring cabbage.

House Plants:

Reduce watering and feeding rates gradually, until the winter minimum is reached.

Paths, Fences and Walls:

Repair or replace damaged fences and walls. Now is the time to consider constructing raised beds, which need strong firm walls.

Ponds:

Clear all debris and decaying vegetation from pools. Take measures to prevent leaves falling into the water.

Wildlife:

Clean and repair bird tables. If you want birds to visit you in the winter months you must ensure a permanent supply of food now.

MY SPACE OR YOURS?

BY LAUREN (AGE 14)

Following on from last month's article about instant messaging, I'd like to write about Myspace, another hugely popular way that people communicate in our internet age.

Unlike Instant Messenger, which is mainly used by younger people, Myspace is beginning to be favoured by more and more adults.

First of all, "What IS Myspace?" It is simply a gigantic website/social network published on the internet and populated by 'users' all over the world.

But more interesting is what you can do with Myspace.

Once registered as a member on Myspace you are given web space to create a webpage called a 'profile'. You then fill the profile with information, pictures, videos and music. When you log on you see your control page, from which you can edit your 'profile', upload pictures and videos, send messages, post a blog (if you don't know what this is don't panic, see Definitions, right) and go to your friends' profiles.

In order for two people to be friends on Myspace, one has to add the other (via a button on their profile) and be accepted by the receiver of the 'friend request'. Once two people are friends they can send comments and messages to each other. Comments are available for everyone to see but messages are private. Once you have four or more friends you can create your 'Top Friends', which enables you to put your closest friends in an order, which you can either hide or display on your profile. Honestly, the amount of fall-outs over 'Top Friends' is ridiculous, which is why many people choose to hide theirs using HTML

codes. HTML can be used to edit your profile in many ways, such as inserting a background for your profile, or making a slideshow of pictures. There are many different HTML help websites available; www.allhtmlcodes.com is a very useful one.

Bulletins are messages, which are sent to all of your friends at once and appear on a bulletin board on the control page of your Myspace.

If a user has uploaded pictures of himself/herself then, if you are their friend, you can leave them picture comments, telling them that you like their new hair or whatever else you may feel compelled to say.

Many people are concerned about the safety of Myspace, as it can allow someone to pretend to be someone they're not; however Myspace has introduced more safety precautions in order to protect Myspace users. For example if a person is under 16, then someone wishing to add them will be required to provide a last name or an email address to show that they really do know the person they are adding, and also the profiles of under 16 year olds are hidden from people who are not already their friend.

With the rise in popularity of this new form of social networking, there has been a huge increase in people seeking 'internet fame'; they add people simply as a means to notoriety by having lots and lots of friends in their network, until it gets to the point where they can be recognized on the street, eg. 'Wow is that BOB off Myspace?!' Yes, it really does happen, but often people adopt Myspace names, almost like stage names; for example if my name is 'Tiffany' I

could call myself 'TiffanyTYRANOSAURUS', which would certainly be comical if I was pointed out on the street.

Acronyms are frequently used on both Myspace and instant messenger programs. Here are just a few you might find useful.

HTML An acronym for Hypertext Markup Language, a standardized system for tagging text files to achieve font, colour, graphic and hyperlink effects on World Wide Web pages.

Finally, the best way to learn about Myspace is to actually try it out for yourself. Many people do not see the attraction of it until they have their own Profile. It is very easy to join and the Worth Valley Mag now even has a Myspace of its own. Visit it at www.myspace.com/worthvalleymag
