

To say I like my barbecue would be an understatement! If we're having guests, I like to offer a couple of vegetarian and vegan

dishes too. This is one of my favourites.

Ingredients

(serves 4)

2 medium / large aubergines
1 tablespoon white miso paste
1 generous tablespoon runny honey
1 teaspoon dark soy sauce
1 teaspoon toasted sesame oil
1 tablespoon sunflower or rapeseed oil
1 small bunch of spring onions, finely sliced

Method

Top and tail your aubergines and take a thin

long slice off both sides (essentially remove the skin from two sides) and discard. Now cut each aubergine lengthways into slices resembling steaks, approximately 2cm thick. Get a large bowl, pot or pan, fill with cold water and salt well. Chuck your aubergine slices into the water, put a plate on top with a kitchen weight to keep the aubergine submerged and set aside for 30 minutes or so. This will remove the bitter taste that puts many off aubergine.

Meanwhile make your marinade by combining the remaining ingredients except the spring onion. You may need to add a little warm water to get the right consistency. You may also wish to add slightly more or less honey or miso to get the balance of salt versus sweet to your taste. We're aiming for a similar consistency to double cream.

Remove your aubergine from the water and pat dry with kitchen roll.

Score both sides of each slice with the point of a sharp knife in a crosshatch pattern. Place in a shallow baking tray and pour over your marinade, turning so both sides are well coated. Set aside for an hour whilst you go and light your barbecue and enjoy a glass of something cold! Once your barbecue grill is good and hot, simply grill the aubergine slices as you would a steak or a burger on the grill rack, timing depends on how hot your barbecue is and how close to the heat you've set your rack. Baste with the marinade as you're cooking. Over a medium to hot heat it should take a couple of minutes a side and should be soft when pricked with a fork.

Remove to a serving plate, pour over a little of the remaining marinade and sprinkle with the spring onion.

I like to serve this with tabouleh or couscous. ~Martin Lingard



One of the many things we love about the Museum is our passionate staff and volunteers – and never is that clearer than at our **Thursday Talks.**

Thursday Talks are delivered once a month, at 2pm, in the Old School

Room – and they're free for locals and Museum ticket-holders!

Sue Newby, Learning Officer at the Parsonage, got the ball rolling for the talks: 'They're a nice way to share our knowledge and enthusiasm with visitors and locals', she says, highlighting how presenters include staff members and volunteers from all different departments within the Museum. From 19th-century women's art to Emily Brontë and vampires – the talks span a huge range of subjects, each one chosen by the presenter because they're fascinated by the topic. 


