

Grease your chosen baking dish with some of your butter. With Easter approaching, I thought I'd Slice the buns in half in the normal way and share this seasonal Easter pudding. It's

butter generously, arranging them in your dish butter side up.

Lob your eggs, egg yolks and sugar into a bowl and beat well for a minute or two. Now tip in your vanilla extract, rum and cream and whisk again until well mixed. Pour this mixture evenly over your buttered buns.


Set this to one side for an hour (out of reach of any pets you may have) to let your buns soak up the custard.

Preheat your oven to 180C.

Grate a good amount of nutmeg over your soggy buns and scatter a little extra caster sugar over everything and put your dish into the oven.

Bake for 35-40 minutes until your buns are golden and crusty.

Serve with extra cream or vanilla ice-cream.




