

Warm Asparagus Mousse with tarragon vinaigrette & toast

Our English asparagus

season is in full swing now. As we get into May, the price drops, and this is a good way of making one bunch feed four as a light lunch or supper. It sounds quite fancy but is really easy.

It is really nice served with a soft boiled egg, toast soldiers and a glass of cold dry white wine. You need four ramekin dishes for this.

Ingredients (serves 4)

I bunch of asparagus 4 large eggs I25 ml double cream Salt & Black pepper I small lump of soft butter I tbsp white wine vinegar Dried tarragon I tsp Dijon mustard 3 tbsp sunflower oil 2 tbsp extra virgin olive oil I small palmful of fresh tarragon leaves, finely chopped Buttered toast to serve

Method

Preheat your oven to 150C (gas mark 2) and butter 4 ramekin dishes. Set these to one side.

Bring a large pan of salted water to the boil. While you're waiting, snap the woody ends off your asparagus spears and chuck in your compost bin. Cut the spears into roughly 2-centimetre lengths and tip into the boiling water. Cook until soft, longer than you'd normally cook asparagus spears. Drain into a colander and cool under the cold tap. Put your asparagus, 2 eggs and a further 2 egg yolks into a blender and process until really smooth. Pour in the cream, season well with salt and pepper then blend again. Pour this mixture into your ramekins. Cover each ramekin with a small square of

tin foil and place them all into a deep baking tray or dish.

Carefully pour hand hot water into the baking tray, avoiding splashing it into your ramekins, until the water comes roughly $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way up.

Transfer the baking tray to the oven, taking care not to slop the water. Bake for 30 minutes before removing and leaving to cool.

Whilst your asparagus mousses are cooling, make a tarragon vinaigrette by mixing the vinegar, dried tarragon and mustard in a bowl then seasoning with salt and pepper. Once mixed, whisk in the oils before finally adding the finely chopped tarragon. Once the mousses have cooled until just warm, pour a small amount of vinaigrette over each one and serve with buttered toast.



BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

In April the Brontë Society celebrated the very first publication of an important miniature manuscript by Charlotte Brontë.

Written when Charlotte was thirteen, **A Book of Ryhmes, sold by nobody and printed by herself,** dated 17 December 1829, contains ten unpublished poems hand-stitched into brown paper covers. After the death of

Charlotte, A Book of Ryhmes was taken to Banagher by Arthur Bell Nicholls, who held it until his death. It disappeared from view in 1916 following a sale at the Walpole Galleries in New York, and for many

years was thought to be lost, but in April 2022 the book was announced as being for sale by James Cummins Rare Books. Following an impressive fundraising campaign, the book was won at auction by the Friends of the National Libraries, and they kindly donated it to the Brontë Parsonage Museum collection.

After publication by Tartarus Press, in association with the Brontë Society, this

remarkable piece of Brontë juvenilia is now available to read for the first time. With an Introduction by songwriter and poet Patti Smith, and essays by Barbara Heritage (a specialist in rare books and manuscripts) and Henry Wessells (an antiquarian bookseller and author), this first edition features reproductions of Charlotte's original handwritten text alongside a transcription of the poems.




On Tuesday 22 April the publication was celebrated at the Old School Room in Haworth, and featured a reading from the book, followed by the opportunity to view the original manuscript in the

Brontë Parsonage Museum.



This year sees **Keighley and District Model Engineering Society** celebrate 75 years since it's formation in May 1950. It was founded with the object of 'fostering the hobby of miniature engineering'. The main interests were in model boats, aeroplanes and railways. The boats included scale models and racing hyroplanes, both of which were sailed on Keighley Tarn. In 1967 a hydroplane built by one of the members set up a new British All-Comers speed record of 108.5 miles per hour. Racing yachts were introduced later and are sailed on the Yorkshire Water reservoir at Weecher.

A desire to build a permanent railway track led to the site at Marley Sports and Activities Centre which was obtained on lease. It took five years of work before the track was opened to the public in 1971. To celebrate our 75 years the railway members are holding a special public running day on **Sunday May 4th.** Miss Joan Hall, who was MP for Keighley at the time, opened the original track, and so as a reflection of that event, Robbie Moore MP has kindly agreed to attend in the afternoon.
