As the nights are drawing in, this dish is real autumnal comfort food. If you find oxtail difficult to source or are put off by the bones, substitute beef shin or

stewing steak. If you do this, it's important it's in thick slices rather than diced. At least one of the big three national supermarkets in Keighley regularly sells oxtail, as do a lot of the local farm shops. It's very good value. This takes a few hours to simmer and is best cooked the night before eating.

Ingredients (serves 4)

2 oxtails, jointed (about 1.5kg if buying pre jointed) or 1kg beef shin OR stewing steak Salt

Black pepper

- 2 heaped tablespoons of plain flour,
- 4 tablespoons of sunflower oil
- 4 garlic cloves, sliced
- I large onion, roughly chopped
- 2 large carrots, sliced
- 2 leeks, sliced

2 celery sticks, sliced

I litre beef stock (a couple of stock cubes dissolved in hot water is fine)2 bay leavesSmall bunch of thymeSmall bunch of parsley

Method

Season the oxtail pieces or beef slices well with salt and black pepper then coat with the flour. This is best done by tipping the flour into a large bowl, lobbing the beef into the bowl and giving it a good old mix with your hands. Put half your oil in a large stovetop casserole dish and place on a high heat. When hot, fry the oxtail

pieces in batches until well browned, remove onto a clean plate and repeat until all your pieces are browned. Add the rest of the oil and chuck in the garlic, onions, carrots, celery and leeks. Lower the heat and fry until the vegetables are softening and browning, stirring frequently. Now tip in the flour you have left from coating your beef and stir well to mix before gradually pouring in your beef stock, stirring as you go.

Bring the liquid to the boil then reduce to a gentle simmer before gently returning your beef to the pot. Add the herbs and season with salt and pepper to taste. Cover with a well fitting lid and cook very gently on the lowest heat possible for 3 hours. If cooking the night before, after 3 hours turn off the heat then leave to cool before covering and refrigerating.

Remove the layer of fat before reheating gently back to a slow simmer. Now carefully remove the pieces of meat to a clean bowl with a slotted spoon, remove the herbs and discard.

Now using a hand blender (or a potato masher!) blend the sauce until it becomes a thick, uniform gravy or sauce. Return the meat to the pot to heat through before serving. I like to serve this with plain boiled potatoes and kale or savoy cabbage.

Also, the replacement. There has been a team of volunteers working for months and months on the preparation and planning for replacement, and you will have seen them hard at work in recent weeks whilst the replacement work has been ongoing. The meticulous planning was proven so worthwhile when the bridge was lifted into place on time and budget, exactly in accordance with the plan, thanks to the leadership of our Chief Civil Engineer, James Barlow. It's been a mighty team effort that helped secure the future of the railway thanks to this investment.

After all that, you might think we deserve a break... but it's only a matter of weeks until our ever-popular Beer & Music Festival that runs from 17th-20th October. This year, we are thrilled to announce a series of Halloweenthemed events with the Spooky Express from the 29th to the 31st of October and the full-October. We can't wait to share these thrilling experiences with you. Ride with us if you dare...

Another new event is an Autumn Steam Up, 4th-6th October, when we welcome a visiting engine to the line to help us celebrate the success of the bridge replacement project and help make up for the few weekends during the work when we were unable to run a steamhauled service.





Nipping at the heels? - plantar fasciitis explained

The human foot is quite an invention! Made up of 26 bones, 33 joints, 107 ligaments, 19 muscles and numerous tendons, it is both complicated and simple Complicated in design but simple in performance, it balances our body weight as we walk, run or stand. Your feet are in constant communication with your brain. The foot is the major sensory organ of the proprioceptive system and each foot is packed with around 200,000 nerve endings. These nerve endings make our feet incredibly responsive and relay detailed information to our brain about everything from pressure to temperature, which is then translated into skilful and effective movement.

Various conditions and types of injury can affect our feet and due to the amount of nerve endings in our feet they are often very painful and debilitating. One such painful conditon is plantar fasciitis. As a medical term, the suffix 'itis' simply means 'inflammation of'. Therefore, the term plantar fasciitis simply describes inflammation of the plantar fascia.

The plantar fascia is a thick, weblike ligament that connects your heel to the front of your foot. It acts as a shock absorber and supports the arch of your foot. The plantarfascia experiences a lot of wear and tear and increased pressure and strain on the ligament can cause damage. The plantar fascia becomes inflamed and the inflammation causes heel pain and stiffness. Heel bone

Plantar fascia pain tends to increase gradually and is typically felt near the heel. Sometimes the pain can be sudden, occuring after missing a step or jumping from a height. The pain tends to be worse in the morning when you get out of bed and take your first few steps, or after other periods of inactivity.

It is not always obvious what has caused this onset of pain in your plantar fascia. However, some of the known risk factors for developing this problem are:

• if you are aged 40 to 60

• if you recently started exercising on hard surfaces

• if you exercise with tight calfs or stiff Achilles tendons

if you have started doing a lot more walking, running or standing up than normal
if you wear shoes with poor cushioning or support i.e high heels, flip-flops, plimsolls
if you are very overweight.

To help reduce your pain you should apply ice to the affected area to reduce the inflammation, stretch the plantar fascia, Achilles tendon and your calf muscles and wear shoes with good arch support and a cushioned sole to minimise the stress on the plantar fascia. You may also find that the anti-inflammatory effect of Ibuprofen can help to reduce your symptoms. Contact your GP or Physical Therapist if symptoms persist.


