There'll be talks, workshops, and free family activities for all ages, and we'll be welcoming a host of fantastic speakers — including much-loved children's author, **Jacqueline Wilson!**

We've been busy behind the scenes getting everything ready – from arranging the theme and booking guests, to spreading the word throughout West Yorkshire and beyond. Programme Officer Angela Clare has been hard at work putting together a spectacular line up:

Poet Maria Ferguson dishing out creative writing at last year's Poetry Takeaway Van.

"It's been great fun creating an eclectic programme with a range of writers across themes and genres with something for all ages. 



If pushed, I'd say this is my favourite recipe to cook and eat. If you're squeamish about eating rabbit or have difficulty sourcing it, a jointed and skinned chicken can be substituted.

Ingredients

(Serves 4)

2 rabbits, skinned and jointed (or 1 large chicken, jointed and skinned)

Sea salt

Freshly ground black pepper 100ml olive oil

I heaped teaspoon coriander seeds, toasted then lightly crushed

I bulb of garlic, separated into peeled cloves

4 bay leaves

250ml dry sherry

500ml water

800g (two tins) of cannellini, haricot or butter beans, washed and drained

I large bunch of flat leaf parsley, roughly chopped

Method

Preheat your oven to 150C (140c if fan

Season your rabbit or chicken joints with sea salt and black pepper. Take a large heavy frying pan and fry your joints in batches in half the olive oil until lightly coloured and lob into a large oven proof pot with a lid. Add the coriander seeds, garlic cloves and bay leaves to the frying pan and gently fry until the garlic cloves are starting to colour. Pour in the sherry, turn up the heat and cook till it starts to bubble.

Now tip everything into your casserole over the meat joints. Add the water, beans and $\frac{3}{4}$ of the parsley to your casserole, place over the heat and bring to a gentle simmer, stirring to mix as you do so. Add your remaining olive oil, pop the lid on your casserole. Transfer to the middle of your oven and cook for 90 minutes or until your meat joints are tender.

Add the remaining parsley and give everything one last stir and serve in bowls. I like to serve this with a green salad and some nice bread to mop up the sauce.
