

Drop-in Advice Sessions: Get Online with NHS App, GP Services, and Social Prescribing

Are you feeling left behind with new online health services? Many people worry about using smartphones or making mistakes, but with a little guidance, you can discover how online systems can work for you. Over the past year, free drop-in sessions hosted by Modality AWC have helped people gain confidence in navigating these services.

Why Online GP Services?

The NHS has evolved significantly, now offering a broad range of services through healthcare professionals working alongside GPs. With increasing demand, online systems help manage GP appointments more efficiently. Submitting an online form allows your request to be triaged immediately. Urgent cases are prioritised, and routine appointments scheduled accordingly sometimes saving you weeks of waiting. For example, some patients attending dropin sessions have reported getting a GP appointment or being referred to a specialist within an hour of completing an online form. Others have been directed to healthcare professionals like physiotherapists, had blood tests arranged in advance, or received guidance from Social Prescribers on resolving healthrelated social issues.

What If I Can't Go Online?

Not everyone finds online systems suitable, and that's okay. You can still call or walk into your GP surgery, where staff can complete the online form for you. However, the more people who choose these traditional options, the longer the queues may become.

More Than GP Access

The NHS App provides convenient features like accessing your consultation records, test results, and hospital letters, as well as ordering



medications in seconds. Other apps, such as Holly Health, can support mental health, prompt medication reminders, and assist with weight loss.

If you're unsure about starting, visit a free dropin session to get personalized guidance. With just a bit of help, you can unlock the benefits of these services and feel more in control of your healthcare journey.

Haworth Cricket Club (HCC) is on West Lane, tucked behind a row of houses. We are a friendly and sociable cricket club with two senior sides and a junior section with teams at Under 9,11,13 & 15. We are very proud of our picturesque ground set amongst farm fields with wonderful views and we welcome everyone who wishes to join us, whether it be to play or spectate. We just want everyone to enjoy the views, the sport, and the club!

HCC is a community club and we are keen to work with local primary schools, churches and other organisations as our facilities can be used all year round. We are contributing to a green environment by having solar panels fitted to our clubhouse roof and hope to be able to extend the changing and clubhouse facilities within the next year, to improve accessibility and inclusivity. Our real ale bar is open on Saturday throughout the season and throughout the winter you will receive a warm welcome and warm fire. We host a variety of village, sporting, and family events throughout the year, many for charitable donations. Last season we hosted a cricket tournament in memory of a past player who sadly passed away in 2024. We raised £1,300 for each of the two benefitting charities, Sue Ryder, and Brain Tumour Trust. We hope to make this an annual event as a fitting tribute.

We formed in 1887 as Haworth Wesleyans CC, with the first match against Lees Albion on September 14, 1889. The first games were played in a Haworth field at 'Long Bridge,' then at Cooke Gate (just off West Lane) until the present ground at West Lane was opened on Saturday 9th June 1951. From 1893, the club played in the Keighley section of the Craven Senior and Junior Cricket Leagues before being admitted to the West Bradford League. The 1940s was the clubs most successful period, winning the League 1944-1948 and completing the double by adding the Keighley cup in 1944-1946. In 1984 HCC joined the Craven and District Cricket League, which the club last won in 2021.



We have several qualified coaches, to cater for all standard of skills and abilities, which help people participate in junior or senior club cricket. Our season starts in April, but indoor winter training starts in February. A British study conducted at the University of Bath found that couples who actively practice gratitude and acknowledge their partner's positive traits ~ despite glaring faults like their inability to load a dishwasher correctly ~ tend to have longer, happier relationships. As the saying goes, love may be blind, but gratitude wears bifocals. Yet, it's not all sunshine and romantic comedies. To truly accept someone is an art that requires patience, a sense of humour, and the ability to



let go of perfection. A survey by Relate, the UK's leading relationship charity, found that a key predictor of relationship satisfaction is the capacity to forgive and adapt. Translation: learning to live with someone's peculiar insistence on talking through every television programme is more important than romantic candlelit dinners; but don't forget the candlelit dinners!

British humour, naturally, offers a way to cope with these irritations. 



The Worth Valley Against Walshaw Wind Farm campaign is gaining momentum. Proposed in September 2023 as England's largest onshore wind farm, the project includes 65 turbines, each up to 200m high, spanning 2,352 hectares (over 9,000 football pitches) across moorland between Top Withens, Pecket Well, and Widdop. The developers now plan to submit revised proposals to the Planning Inspectorate this spring, bypassing Calderdale Council.

The site lies within the South Pennine Moors SSSI, the largest area of unenclosed moorland in West Yorkshire. It is a Special Protection Area for birds, including red-listed curlews, skylarks, lapwings, golden plovers, merlins, and twites. Additionally, it's designated as a Special Area of Conservation for its priority-protected blanket bog, peatland habitats, and associated wildlife and plants. These protections, rooted in UK law, highlight the moor's ecological importance.

While we support clean energy, wind farms on peatlands fail to deliver the desired benefits. Peatlands store carbon and sustain biodiversity, but wind farm construction on peat releases stored carbon and damages fragile habitats. In a recent government consultation, 90% of respondents called for stronger protections for peat soils.

Our campaign seeks a ban on wind farms on protected peatland. A petition to Parliament is pending approval, so stay tuned for updates via our website and social media. Meanwhile, we urge constituents to contact Robbie Moore MP, asking him to lobby Ed Miliband for a ban.

BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

Happy New Year from everyone at the Brontë Parsonage Museum! 2025 is set to be an incredible year for all of us in the Bradford area, as we celebrate City of Culture right on our doorsteps. Keep

a lookout for events and opportunities throughout the next twelve months – some of which are happening right here in Haworth. Now the new year is underway, we're excited to reveal the theme of our special 2025 exhibition, which opens in February. This one has a particularly local focus.

From Haworth to Eternity: The Enduring Legacy of

the Brontës charts the rise of Brontëmania, especially on film and TV, putting Haworth's role centre stage.

Highlights of the exhibition include early souvenirs from the Parsonage and props from Sally Wainwright's 2016 film, To Walk Invisible. Particularly tantalising is the production script from the first, silent film adaptation of Wuthering Heights in 1920, which will also be on display. The script details all the instructions for producing the film – but the film itself has never been found.

Haworth's history is entwined with the story of the three sisters, and many of

the precious items we have in our care have come to us from local families and friends of the Brontës. We're continuing our local history theme with a talk which digs into the murky world of sanitation

> in the nineteenth century, lifting the lid on hygiene at the time of the Brontës. Happily, this coincides with the opening of our brandnew (squeaky-clean!) visitor and **Changing** Places facilities. Our new exhibition. the opening of our visitor facilities, and our sanitation talk all take place on **Saturday I** February, and we'd love to see you there!

The talk is free for local residents (and with entry to the Museum) – and if you're lucky, you might just spot a couple of friendly, talking flowerpot men outside the visitor facilities, a sure sign that spring is on the horizon. Find out more about the new season at the Museum over on our 'What's on' page. Just head to our recently refreshed website, bronte.org.uk. 



Leftovers Chicken and Vegetable Stew with Dumplings



~ Martin Lingard

This is a great dish for winter as it is hearty, warming, tasty and healthy, plus very economical. It makes good use of leftovers and any veg you may have hanging about in the fridge, freezer or

store cupboard. It does take a few hours to make, but most of this time is just the stock simmering slowly, leaving you free to crack on with other stuff...Feeds 4 well.

Ingredients

For the stock:

Leftover roast chicken carcass I medium onion, peeled

- I large leek, thickly sliced
- 2 carrots, cut into chunks
- 2 celery ribs roughly chopped (plus leaves)
- A thumb sized bit of ginger root, peeled & sliced
- 2 or 3 garlic cloves
- a dozen or so peppercorns
- a bunch of herbs (parsley, sage, bay, thyme etc)

For the stew:

- 4 tbsp pearl barley
- 2 tbsp soy sauce
- 4 carrots, peeled and diced
- 2 medium potatoes, peeled and diced Mixed green veg' - whatever you have to hand (frozen peas, green beans, bag of spinach etc) Leftover roast chicken

For the dumplings:

75g suet I 50g self-raising flour ½ tsp salt & pepper

Method

Take your chicken carcass, remove all the remaining meat and set to one side in a bowl. Break up the remaining carcase and wings, legs & thighs and place in a large stockpot, skin, bones, jelly & all. Chuck all your other ingredients into your pot too, you can also add spices such as a few cloves, a star anise, a handful of coriander



seeds and a few chilli flakes here too if you wish. Cover with 2 to 3 litres of water and bring to the boil. Once boiling, put on the lowest possible heat setting, skim off any scum, bob on a lid and leave for 2 to 3 hours, go and watch a movie!

When time's up, drain through a colander into a large bowl or pot, discard all the bones and veg'. Clean your stockpot then strain the stock through a fine sieve back into your stockpot. Return your pot to a high heat, add your pearl barley and soy sauce. A glug of sherry works well too here if you have any left from Christmas!

Boil without a lid for 15 to 20 minutes, this is to ensure the barley is cooked and it also concentrates the flavour.

Add the carrots and potatoes, turnips, swede or parsnips can be used as well or instead of here if that is what you have. Season to taste. Reduce to a simmer, bob on a lid and leave for 20 minutes while you make your dumplings. To make the dumplings, lob the flour, salt, suet and a bit of ground pepper into a mixing bowl, mix with the back of a knife, adding one tablespoon of water at a time. After 3 to 4 tablespoons, you will have a firm springy dough. Roll into approximately 12 small (walnut) sized balls.

Now remove the lid, add the green veg' and chicken and stir well then lower your dumplings on top, spooning some liquid over them. Bring back to a simmer and cook for another 10 to 15 minutes before serving in deep bowls.


