'Green Energy Gone Wrong'- Why we must say no to Walshaw Moor Wind Farm

Plans have been submitted to build England's largest onshore wind farm; 65 colossal turbines towering over the wild, ecologically rich landscape of Walshaw Moor in the Calder Valley. On paper, it sounds like green progress. In reality, it's anything but.

This isn't a rejection of renewable energy. Wind power is vital. But placing a vast industrial development on one of the most sensitive and protected peatland areas in the country is not progress, it's environmental vandalism.

Walshaw Moor stores massive amounts of carbon in its peat. In fact, UK peatland stores 26 times more carbon than forests. Disturbing it to construct turbines taller than Blackpool Tower would release huge quantities of carbon into the atmosphere. Ironically, this so-called green energy project would unleash a carbon bomb. The moor also plays a critical role in flood prevention. Its blanket bog absorbs rainfall and slows runoff, protecting communities like Hebden Bridge, Mytholmroyd, and Todmorden, places that have endured devastating floods in recent years. Construction would damage this natural flood defence, undermining millions in public investment and years of community effort.

Beyond the environmental cost, there's a serious economic impact. The two-year build would close off cherished walking routes, including parts of the Pennine Way, threatening local tourism and hospitality businesses already under strain. An RSPB study confirms that there's ample land in England suitable for wind farms without building on protected peatlands. The government's obsession with scale, the 'biggest wind farm in England,' must not come at the expense of irreplaceable landscapes and climate stability. This is not nimbyism. It's common sense. We need renewable energy, but not like this. For the sake of our climate, our safety, and our communities, we must oppose the Walshaw Moor Wind Farm.

I'm not vegetarian, but I do enjoy cooking and eating vegetarian food. Some of my friends are vegetarians, so whenever I host a barbecue, I always make sure to include at least one proper veggie option. That said, I've yet to find a shop-bought vegetarian sausage or burger that hasn't ended up in the bin after the first bite... This is one of my favourite vegetarian barbecue dishes—simple to make, full of flavour, and always popular.

Ingredients (Serves 6) 2 medium cauliflowers Olive oil 150g unsalted butter, cut into 6 slices Salt and black pepper Baking parchment 6 tbsp flat-leaf parsley, chopped 2 tbsp pine nuts, toasted 4 fat garlic cloves, finely chopped 1 large unwaxed lemon, zested Method

First, fire up your barbecue; you want it medium to hot, as you would for grilling a steak or burger. If you can control the temperature, aim for around 180°C. Trim the leaves from the cauliflowers and turn them upside down. Cut each one into three thick, steak-like slices from the root end, keeping the root intact so the slices hold together.

Brush both sides of each cauliflower 'steak' with olive oil and season well with salt and pepper. Grill on both sides until nicely charred and golden. Once done, transfer to a plate.

Line a large, inexpensive steel or aluminium roasting tin or baking tray with baking parchment. Arrange the grilled cauliflower slices inside; it's fine if they overlap a bit. Place a slice of butter on top of each piece, season lightly, and cover with more parchment, folding the edges together to make a loose parcel.

Place the tin on the barbecue. If it has a lid, close it; if not, cover loosely with foil to create a tent. Cook for 20–30 minutes until the cauliflower is tender. While the cauliflower cooks, make the

gremolata: mix the toasted pine nuts, parsley, garlic, and lemon zest in a bowl. If you like a bit of heat, add a finely chopped red chilli.To serve, arrange the cauliflower slices on a platter and scatter a generous pinch of gremolata over each one.

Temporary Guests: Sculptures and Stories on the Hill

An invitation to pause, puzzle, and see differently. Walkers on Penistone Hill this summer will have noticed something unfamiliar among the quarry stone, bracken and heather: towering sculptures, giant butterflies, and strange new forms placed in the landscape. These are part of **Wild Uplands**, a temporary outdoor sculpture trail created for Bradford 2025's UK City of Culture programme. Reactions have been mixed. Some people are delighted. Others puzzled; and some are just not keen. And that's OK. Public art doesn't need universal approval. What it offers instead is a moment, a pause, a question, a different angle. A chance to see something anew, or not. Take **Steve Messam's Tower**. From a distance, it might seem comic, something out of Spinal Tap: a woolly, Stonehenge-like structure, plonked on the hill, incongruous and questionable. But walk up to it and something shifts. Its bulk feels monolithic and modern. You can duck inside the arch to find shelter from the wind; sound is muffled by the thick fleece. It's tactile, slightly

ridiculous, and quietly profound. It makes me smile. And like the sheep it references, it even sheds, tufts of wool catching on the breeze. In the former quarry spoil, **Meherunnisa Asad's 99 Butterflies** cluster around a popular watering hole. Looking down from the hill above the installation, the butterflies jar at first, almost littering the landscape, and taking space where locals notoriously like to linger with their dogs or horses. It is necessary to walk down aand get up close to the butterflies to fully appreciate their beauty. Pink onyx wings, handcarved by artisans in Pakistan, reveal intricate patterns and decorative details. They are fairly weighty and rigid objects, ironically grounded and immovable, though not suitable for crawling or climbing on like the Muamba Posy installation further along the trail. To me, the butterflies speak of migration and arriving in a new place, seen but not always appreciated or understood. Vanessa da Silva's Muamba Posy sculptures look like they've bloomed straight from a Virtual Reality dreamscape. Flower-like formations, biological shapes, but not as we know them. These sturdy forms are made for sitting, leaning, and interacting with. They speak of transformation, otherness, diaspora, and new roots taking hold. Unapologetically vibrant, they feel present and alive, cheerfully alien. And then there's Monira Al Qadiri's Children of Smokeless Fire: mythical

figures drawn from Middle Eastern folklore. "Smokeless fire" refers to Djinn, beings made from pure energy. The figures are flat, yet somehow multi-dimensional, like echoes from another realm. They bring to mind our own Cottingley Fairies, famously photographed just a few miles away over a century ago. Both sets of beings blur myth and belief, inviting curiosity and storytelling in equal measure.

Threaded through all of this is **Earth & Sky**, a GPS-triggered soundscape by Opera North.As you move through the landscape, it blends poetry, field recordings, and music, creating an auditory experience some describe as dreamlike, though others walk through without noticing it at all. Not everyone wants to engage deeply with art on a walk. Some prefer the moors just as they are and that's fair too. These are shared spaces. **Wild Uplands** offers

a second look. A reason to linger. A question to carry. And maybe that's the point: not to instruct, but to invite. To make space for humour, strangeness, and surprise. To ask whether the unfamiliar really threatens us or whether it might just be waiting for us to look a little closer. The sculptures remain in place until October. You might find something interesting in them: a story, a shelter, or even a smile. For more information, maps and walking routes visit **bradford2025.co.uk.**
