

Upper Town chippy was reopened by Oxnop resident Rae Rae Foxon in 2022 after being shut for two years.
"The chippy has always been a culinary institution

in the village and I couldn't stand seeing it being shut any longer; one morning I realised that if no one was going to reopen the business then I'd better just have a go," Rae Rae explains.

A thirty something bubbly jubilant business lady, Rae Rae has had more than just a go; she, with the help of her husband and their army of friends, overhauled the place into a hip yet traditional looking Fish & Chips shop.

"Not only did I want to serve the most traditional of Fish and Chips, I also wanted the shop to have a nostolgic feel. We cook in a range once sited on Blackpool Pier." Rae Rae says, "It's nearly 60 years old and I had to overhaul her inner workings to bring her up to a modern spec. They used to light the old thing with a match! I've named her Frida," she smiles.





Upon entering **Upper Town Fish & Chips** you are greeted with one of those pin board menus that you might have seen in 1980's cafes listing a varied menu of delights from fresh haddock and chips, cauliflower bites, halloumi, to the intriguing pizza crunch (battered pizza) and lots of options for vegetarians and vegans. Rae Rae even offers homemade pickled eggs from her own flock of free range hens, also based in the village.

This all female run business has been getting busier and busier since opening and the reviews are getting better still.

"It's been a challenge from day one. When a business has been shut for so long it's about building support from the ground up; the local community as well as others further afield have been great. We've had to work hard to get back on the map, but we love it: We offer good quality produce that is locally sourced and closely guard our secret batter recipe!"



In 1992. Al Health & Mobility began its journey in a humble garage in Haworth, under the guidance of current MD Simon Harrison. Initially, the focus was on selling reconditioned stairlifts to the local community. Word of their commitment to quality workmanship led to nationwide recognition within the lift industry in the UK. 



This may seem an unusual way to cook and serve fish but it's actually quite common in Northern France and Belgium, I've eaten a similar dish of fish cooked in cider in Normandy.

I've used lemon sole here but most flat fish fillets such as brill, halibut, turbot or plaice can be substituted. A pale ale or pilsner style lager is best for this. I like to keep it local and use Timothy Taylors Landlord. It can be quite difficult sourcing good fresh fish in the Worth and Aire Valley area. I tend to go to the fish mongers on Albion Street on the outside of Halifax market which are very good but there is also a good fishmonger on the High Street in likley. I like to serve this with boiled new potatoes and green beans. (Feeds 4)

#### **Ingredients**

100g unsalted butter

I medium onion, halved & thinly sliced

2 celery sticks, thinly sliced

500ml pale ale or lager

I bay leaf

I sprig each of fresh parsley & thyme

4 juniper berries, squished

4 lemon sole fillets, skinned if you prefer Sea salt and freshly ground black pepper

#### Method

You need a wide and shallow stovetop pot for this recipe. You also need to have warmed serving dishes ready.

Warm your pot over a medium heat and chuck in half the butter. Lob in your onion and celery and cook gently until soft stirring occasionally.

Now pour in your beer, add the herbs and juniper berries, turn up the heat and bring to a simmer.

Gently lower in your fish fillets, in a single layer, don't worry if they overlap. Bring back to a simmer and poach gently for 4-5minutes, dependent on the thickness of your fish.

Using a fish slice, carefully remove the fish fillets onto your warmed plates and cover with foil.

Whack up the heat and reduce the volume of liquid in your pot by a good half. Add the remaining butter to the beer, stirring vigorously until it's dissolved to make a sauce. Season well with salt and pepper then strain into a jug before pouring over the fish.

# BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM



It feels like the world has burst into life in Haworth! June's the month for colour, fresh summer scents, and bird song - and here at the Brontë Parsonage we're embracing the change with a few green initiatives... You might have noticed a patch of land on Church Street, next to the Old School Room. At first glance, it's overgrown and unkempt - but believe us when we say it's deliberate!

Leaving an area to grow as it likes creates a haven for wildlife, encouraging flowers to bloom and long grasses to grow. These habitats are a safe spot for beetles and birds - not to mention pollinators, like bees and butterflies. In fact, creating a wilderness corner has been shown to increase butterfly

numbers by up to 93%, attracting a wider range of species at the same time. The Brontës were heavily inspired by the natural world around them – and especially by the local landscapes we know and love today. It wasn't just stormy moorland scenes that made their way into the sisters' writing either; a deep appreciation and knowledge of animals, plants, and landscapes alike is clear throughout their work. We're planning on giving our corner of wilderness a helping hand this summer, making sure the flowers there can thrive. Watch out for a path and perhaps a bench too – a spot for anyone to sit and enjoy the wildlife buzzing and blooming. Speaking of planting, our gardening volunteer team has been hard at work in the Parsonage Garden and we're excited to be using our own compost. This is great news for two reasons - first, because we're helping to stop compostable food and garden waste going to landfill, and second, because we're not relying on shop-bought compost which comes in difficult-to-recycle plastic bags.

The gardening team has also installed a second water butt, made from a reclaimed wooden barrel. It's another win for sustainability - and a nod to gardening practices used when the Brontës lived here in the 1800s. We think the sisters would approve!

Visit the Museum every day of the week this summer, except Tuesdays. Local rates are £7.50, children are free, and once you've bought a ticket you can come again for 12 months at no extra cost. Head to bronte.co.uk/visit-us to find out more.




