



Tales from Oscar's Farm:

Where Community & Imagination Meet



Looking out over the Worth Valley from my home above Oxenhope, I used to watch the wildlife with my children. That view sparked an idea, and before long, a quirky

community of animals came to life in my imagination—Oy Ewe the sheep, Philip the pheasant, Stanley the squirrel, and others. Ten years ago, I wrote and printed five little stories for family and friends. But the characters wouldn't leave me. Rooted in our Yorkshire landscape, they evolved into a trilogy:The Accident, The Birth, and The Mystery. Each story is filled with fun and gentle lessons: twites (rare local birds) and compass points in one; a kitchen calf and a three-legged mole in another; and in The Mystery, hens named April, May, June, and Julie help explain the food chain. And yes, there are maps. I love maps!

About the Author, Pauline Brown.

Pauline is a storyteller, mother of three, and long-time Worth Valley resident who first discovered Yorkshire while studying at Bradford University. One of seven sisters, with a Swiss mum and a fondness for adventure, she's worked with homeless people, families in crisis, and the courts. Her love of wildlife, community, and the view from her window inspired the Oscar's Farm stories: gentle, imaginative tales rooted in nature and friendship.

From parachuting and painting silk to walking 500 miles on the Camino, Pauline brings curiosity and kindness to everything she does.

A few years ago, family friend Mark Purvis introduced me to International Mixed Ability Sport (IMAS), based in Bradford. I saw a chance to use the Oscar's Farm characters to write about inclusion for children of all abilities. With support from the IMAS team and inspiration from a young person named Cam, Diego's Team was born.

Diego the alpaca, a newcomer to the farm, meets ferrets Cedric and Bob and helps bring the community together. As IMAS founder Mark Goodwin says, the story "encourages empathy and understanding... helping to break down barriers between disabled and non-disabled children."

Now published under Worth The Read, the books are available in local KWVR shops, Betty Moore, Haworth Main Street, Book Case in Hebden Bridge, and Truman Books at Farsley. Diego's Team will be featured at special launch events for schools funded by Bradford City of Culture. A public reading takes place at Waterstones during the Bradford Literature Festival on Saturday 5th July.



Ingredients

(serves 4)
2 x skate wings,
approximately 500g each,
skinned

4 tablespoons of white wine vinegar

I teaspoon of salt I 50g unsalted butter 50ml red wine vinegar I tablespoon capers, drained and rinsed I tablespoon chopped parsley

Method

Pour enough cold water into your pot so there will be enough to just


cover the skate wings by a few centimetres. Tip in the white wine vinegar and the salt and bring to a gentle simmer. Gently slide in both skate wings and gently poach for around 15 minutes until tender. Drain and carefully remove both wings to a warmed serving dish, cover loosely with foil to keep them warm.

Now, working quickly, melt your butter over a medium to high heat in a frying pan. Pay close attention.

You're waiting for the butter to melt and start to foam. Once foaming, it should start to smell a bit nutty or toasty, and start to darken. Be careful, dependent on how hot you've got your pan, this can happen very quickly!

As soon as it gets a nice golden colour, quickly pour in the red wine vinegar and stir. Now chuck in your parsley and capers, stirring, bring back to a simmer then tip everything over both skate wings and serve immediately. **Enjoy!**

supermarkets put a lot of fishmongers out of business. I go to Albion Street in Halifax on the outside of the market where there are two stalls next-door to each other. There's also a good one on the High Street in Skipton. Skate wings are a lot cheaper than cod or haddock now. People who are put off fish by the bones will love this recipe too as the meat just slides off the cartilage; no bones!

Two skate wings, approximately 500g each will easily feed four people.

I like to serve this with plain boiled new potatoes and green beans.

You will need a large pan that will easily accommodate both skate wings together.







Haworth Heritage Trail

- Start at the Brontë Parsonage Museum then head down Church Street a few metres to the Old School Room on your left. Turn right into the churchyard, pausing by the steps and the graveyard. This small churchyard is crammed with hundreds of gravestones of local villagers - the weavers, the stonemasons, the clog makers. The average life expectancy was only around 25 years! Follow the path left around St Michael and All Angels Church, which is well worth a visit and is often open to welcome visitors.
- Turn right, down the steps onto Main Street and a small cobbled area. This square was once the heart of the community, where exhausted horses could rest after pulling carts up the steep road!
- Continue downhill on Main Street to the small passageway on your right leading to Lodge Street. Look down Lodge Street to see a courtyard characteristic of the 1800s: large families would share one or two rooms. whilst some of the poorest lived in damp basements below street level.
- Continue down to the Old Hall before heading onto Bridgehouse Road as it curves down the hill towards the valley bottom. Stop on the bridge and peek over to see the Keighley and Worth Valley Railway.
 - On the far side of the bridge take the first right into River View. Ahead is all that remains of Bridgehouse Mill, the first in a ribbon of textile mills that threaded through

Keighley the valley.

Valley View

- (6) Head through the central archway and follow the road through the modern housing estate. At the end, you'll come to a footpath by the beck. Bridgehouse Mill was one of the first textile mills to be powered by water. The beck was fed into a channel or 'goit' and into a dam to power the water wheel which drove the spinning machines. Follow the path through a metal kissing gate.
- At a ruined farm building on the left take the right fork and head through the stone stile. Follow the path across the courtyard of the cottages. Immediately after, take the gap in the fence to your right and follow the path downhill back towards the valley bottom. Continue along the riverside path until you reach an ancient stone bridge over the beck.
- Donkey Bridge is part of a centuries old packhorse trail that was used to transport goods across the country. Cross the bridge, head under the railway arch and follow the packhorse trail as it slopes up the valley. Continue past Marsh End Farm until the path meets Marsh Lane.
- 9 Turn left onto Marsh Lane, passing all the houses, then turn right onto Old Oxenhope Lane. As the road bends sharply left, enter the farmyard and go straight on, looking out for the footpath signs. Leave the farmyard and continue on the track into the field. Keep left at the two windmills and pass through the small gap in the wall. This leads to a section of wall lined path. Continue straight ahead towards the line of conifer trees.
- Pass through the small wooden gate, keeping the conifer trees on your right. At the end of the trees cross the track and continue through the small metal gate signed Haworth Main St. Pass through two fields and at the end turn right into the stone walled path.
- (11) Follow the walled path round as it zig-zags before straightening out into a paved path leading to a kissing gate and back to the Parsonage graveyard.
