

#### **Wyedean's gift of rest** and reflection for **Haworth Main Street**

Haworth's Wyedean Weaving is delighted to announce the installation of three new benches on the lower part of the town's main street.

The three hand crafted benches replace former, deteriorating seating on Haworth Main Street and have been designed and made by local, skilled tradespeople as part of Wyedean's 60th anniversary pledges to give back to its local community.

Managing Director Robin Wright said: "During our 60th anniversary year we pledged to give back, in a number of ways, to our local community. Since last April we have planted 30 apple trees in Haworth Park, we have pledged to support Haworth Church and have most recently invested in the design, construction and installation of three new benches for Haworth Main Street.

"We never underestimate the role that local people, our neighbours and the wider community play in the success of our business and we wanted tangible ways to say thank you for their decades of support in this, our Diamond Anniversary year."

The bench project was suggested by Haworth Village Council and approved by Bradford Metropolitan District Council. They were created with the help of local businesses who used locally sourced materials. Wyedean has offered its special thanks to lake Chamley of Chamley Engineering & Fabrication in Silsden,

Robin added: "All four benches were built in our workshop with Jake, Ken, and myself testing the prototype for comfort! The prototype will sit proudly outside Wyedean's entrance, while the other three benches sit proudly on Main Street and encourage Haworth's visitors to take a moment to reflect, rest and enjoy their surroundings."





## **Motherhood:**A Conversation Across Time

I can still see my mother standing in the kitchen. sleeves rolled up, hands dusted with flour, focused on rolling out the perfect dough. She was just as meticulous about the laundry—how to fold fitted sheets, an obsession lost on me. She was an "always make your bed first thing in the morning" type of person, with hospital corners as a non-negotiable. If the beds weren't made, I knew something was amiss. She wasn't one for sentimental speeches, but there was something in the way she moved-efficient, nononsense—that spoke volumes. She didn't hover, didn't coddle, but you always knew where you stood with her. She believed in getting on with things, in facing life looking forward. When I think about my mother, I don't recall long heart-to-hearts or grand gestures of affection. Instead, I remember practical acts of care: the way she kept everything running smoothly, the quiet way she supported us, her absolute belief that problems were to be solved, not dwelled upon. There were times when I wished for a bit more softness, a bit more space for vulnerability. But looking back, I understand now that love doesn't always announce itself in the way we expect. It was there, in the steadiness, in the reliability, in the way she always—always—showed up. And then I became a mother, I imagined I'd be

different. I'd be more open, more emotionally available, more willing to let my child see my uncertainties. And yet, I find my mother's voice slipping out of my mouth more often than I'd like to admit. "Just get on with it." "You'll be fine." "No need to make a fuss."

My daughter, though, is not me. She has grown up in a world where feelings are dissected and discussed, where vulnerability isn't a weakness but a language she speaks fluently. She challenges me in ways I never anticipated. When I try to brush things off, she pushes back. She asks me how I'm feeling, and sometimes I don't know what to tell her. There are moments when she looks at me like I am an unsolvable puzzle, and I wonder if she knows that I often feel like one, too. And yet, there's something genuinely funny about this ongoing negotiation between generations. My mother still believes in the virtues of stiff upper lips and neatly made beds—hospital corners mandatory. I straddle the divide, part pragmatist, part introspective work-in-progress, trying to balance resilience with emotional openness. And then there's my daughter, who has no qualms about processing her feelings aloud, declaring boundaries, and reminding me that "just getting on with it" isn't always the answer. She teases me when I default to my mother's no-nonsense phrases, and I catch myself rolling my eyes at the ones she's picked up from her world. We're three women, shaped by different eras, occasionally bewildered by each other, but somehow making it work. Mother's Day, for me, isn't about flowers or breakfast in bed, though both are lovely. It's about recognising that motherhood is a conversation that stretches across time, between generations; there are lingering codes and unwritten patterns. It's about the things we inherit and the things we choose to leave behind. It's about the momentsbig and small—that shape us. It's about understanding that love is not always spoken, but for me, it is always there. So, to my mother: I understand you now more than ever. To my daughter: You are teaching me as much as I am teaching you.

And to myself: You're doing okay.

That's enough.

As local residents, you probably know a thing or two more than most about Patrick Brontë. You'll likely know he was the father of the famous Brontë sisters, and perhaps that he was the vicar at Haworth church. opposite what's now the Brontë Parsonage Museum.

on 17 March, 1777 - on Saint Patrick's Day itself! This March, we're celebrating Patrick Brontë by walking in his footsteps, getting to know the man who raised three of literature's greatest writers.

Before starting his curacy at Haworth, Patrick preached for five years in nearby Thornton – where the Brontë children were born. On Sunday 16 March, we'll be joined by local historian and guide Steven Stanworth, who'll take us on a guided tour of the 'Brontë Bell

> Chapel' in St James Church, Thornton. Then, on Monday 17 **March**, we'll be striding out on one of Patrick's favourite walks along the river in **Dewsbury**. 

DON'T GET MAD, GET PICKING!















At the time of writing this month's recipe, it's still cold and damp; Cullen Skink is a hearty and comforting soup and a really easy dish to make that originates from the town of Cullen in the east coast of Scotland. It's worth trying to source undyed smoked haddock rather than the mucky artificial yellow stuff you sometimes see in supermarkets. It's also important to use full fat milk rather than skimmed or semi skimmed, gold top is even better. I like to add a small 100g bag of baby spinach just before serving and topping with a poached egg, but this is optional and it certainly isn't the Scottish way.

**Ingredients** (This feeds four generously)

75g butter

I large onion, chopped

1.5 litres full fat milk

Ikg potatoes, peeled and cut into

smallish chunks

700g smoked haddock fillet

I small bunch of flat leaf parsley,

roughly chopped

100g bag of baby leaf spinach (optional)

Sea salt

Freshly ground black pepper

4 poached eggs (optional)

#### Method

Start by melting your butter in a large, heavy stove top pot over a low heat. Add your

onions and cook slowly for 10 minutes until they are very soft, stirring occasionally so they don't brown.

Add your potatoes, stir and pour in your milk. Increase the heat, bring to a very gentle simmer and cook for 20 minutes until your potatoes are starting to fall apart. Now place the fish on top of your milk and potatoes, pushing it down gently until just covered by the milk and cook for a further 4 minutes.

Once cooked, carefully lift the fish out and place on a plate to cool.

Whilst your fish is cooling, get a potato masher and roughly mush the potatoes and onions into the milk – we're aiming for a course, rough, soup like consistency, not a smooth puree.

Once cool enough to handle, coarsely flake your fish, chucking away the skin and any bones you find.

Now return the flaked fish to your pot with the parsley and season generously with black pepper and salt. Warm through for a couple of minutes, stirring occasionally whilst you poach the eggs if you have decided to take this option. If you're adding the baby spinach, do so a minute before serving, stirring it in to mix as it wilts. Serve in deep bowls, placing a poached egg on top of the soup in each bowl.

#### Hip Hip Hooray – But No Cheer for Arthritis!



#### When Surgery Becomes Necessary

If pain becomes severe and mobility is significantly reduced, total hip replacement may be the best option. This common and highly successful surgery provides pain relief and restores function.

One patient, after years of suffering, walked five miles the day after surgery—though not surgeon-recommended, it demonstrates the procedure's transformative impact.

By staying active and maintaining a healthy weight, many can delay or even avoid surgery. But when needed, hip replacement can be lifechanging. ~ David Hanson


