On 8 May 1945, jubilant crowds flooded the streets of Britain to mark Victory in Europe (VE) Day, celebrating the end of World War II in Europe. As the nation commemorates the 80th anniversary of this historic day. it's a poignant moment to reflect on the sacrifices made and the enduring peace that followed.

In London, throngs gathered outside Buckingham Palace, cheering as King George VI and Prime Minister Winston Churchill appeared on the balcony. Street parties erupted nationwide, with communities dancing and singing in shared relief and joy.



Rare color footage captures these spontaneous celebrations, offering a vivid glimbse into the nation's elation.

Bradford and the Keighley District played a significant role in the war effort. Bradford's textile industry was vital, producing uniforms and materials essential for the military. The city's mills operated tirelessly, contributing to the supply chain that supported the troops. In Keighley, local factories shifted to wartime production, manufacturing components and equipment crucial for the front lines.

The region's contribution extended beyond industry. Many residents served in the armed forces, with local regiments seeing action across various theaters of war. The community's resilience and commitment

were instrumental in the collective war effort.

As we honor VE Day's 80th anniversary, it's essential to remember the unity and determination that defined that era. The sacrifices made by communities like Bradford and Keighley underscore the importance

of preserving peace and remembering our shared history.

Thursday May 8th 2025, beacons and Lamp Lights of Peace will shine across the United Kingdom to commemorate 80 years since VE Day.

Keighley Town Council is hosting a community celebration at Town Hall Square (BD21 3QQ) from 6:00 PM to 9:45 PM.

The event will feature:

* Face painting * Lindy Hop dance lessons *1940s tractor display *Free picnic for the first 100 attendees *Beacon lighting ceremony at 9:15 PM

Additionally, **Bingley Remembrance** Group, in conjunction with the

Town Council, are organising two events for the commemoration of the 80th anniversary of Victory in Europe Day on 8th May 2025. Bingley will also hold a beacon lighting ceremony at its cenotaph. The event will feature local groups, including cadets, choirs, and marching bands. The bells of All Saints Parish Church in Bingley are expected to participate in the national "Ring Out for Peace" at 6:30 PM. A family event is being organised in Bingley Market Square for Saturday 10th May 2025, in conjunction with RSH Artisan Markets also. The latter will include musical performances, classic army vehicles, food and drink, and even an RAF flypast!

Warm Asparagus Mousse with tarragon vinaigrette & toast

Our English asparagus season is in full swing now. As we get into May, the price drops, and this is a good way of making one bunch feed four as a light lunch or supper. It sounds quite fancy but is really easy. It is really nice served with a soft boiled egg, toast soldiers and a glass of cold dry white wine. You need four ramekin dishes for this.

Ingredients (serves 4)

Buttered toast to serve

I bunch of asparagus 4 large eggs I 25 ml double cream Salt & Black pepper I small lump of soft butter I tbsp white wine vinegar Dried tarragon I tsp Dijon mustard 3 tbsp sunflower oil 2 tbsp extra virgin olive oil I small palmful of fresh tarragon leaves, finely chopped

Method

Preheat your oven to 150C (gas mark 2) and butter 4 ramekin dishes. Set these to one side.

Bring a large pan of salted water to the boil. While you're waiting, snap the woody ends off your asparagus spears and chuck in your compost bin. Cut the spears into roughly 2-centimetre lengths and tip into the boiling water. Cook until soft, longer than you'd normally cook asparagus spears. Drain into a colander and cool under the cold tap. Put your asparagus, 2 eggs and a further 2 egg yolks into a blender and process until really smooth. Pour in the cream, season well with salt and pepper then blend again. Pour this mixture into your ramekins. Cover each ramekin with a small square of tin foil and place them all into a deep baking tray or dish.

Carefully pour hand hot water into the baking tray, avoiding splashing it into your ramekins, until the water comes roughly $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way up.

Transfer the baking tray to the oven, taking care not to slop the water. Bake for 30 minutes before removing and leaving to cool.

Whilst your asparagus mousses are cooling, make a tarragon vinaigrette by mixing the vinegar, dried tarragon and mustard in a bowl then seasoning with salt and pepper. Once mixed, whisk in the oils before finally adding the finely chopped tarragon. Once the mousses have cooled until just warm, pour a small amount of vinaigrette over each one and serve with buttered toast.

BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

In April the Brontë Society celebrated the very first publication of an important miniature manuscript by Charlotte Brontë.

Written when Charlotte was thirteen. A Book of Ryhmes, sold by nobody and printed by herself, dated 17 December 1829, contains ten

unpublished poems hand-stitched into brown paper covers. After the death of

Charlotte. A Book of Ryhmes was taken to Banagher by Arthur Bell Nicholls, who held it until his death. It disappeared from view in 1916 following a sale at the Walpole Galleries in New York, and for many

years was thought to be lost, but in April 2022 the book was announced as being for sale by James Cummins Rare Books. Following an impressive fundraising campaign, the book was won at auction by the Friends of the National Libraries, and they kindly donated it to the Brontë Parsonage Museum collection.

After publication by Tartarus Press, in association with the Brontë Society, this remarkable piece of Brontë juvenilia is now available to read for the first time. With an Introduction by songwriter and poet Patti Smith, and essays by Barbara Heritage (a specialist in rare books and manuscripts) and Henry Wessells (an antiquarian bookseller and author), this first edition features reproductions of Charlotte's original handwritten text alongside a transcription of the poems.

On Tuesday 22 April A BOOK OF BYHNES the publication was celebrated at the CALOTTEBRONTS Old School Room NOBODYAND in Haworth, and featured a reading from the book. followed by the opportunity to view the original manuscript in the

Brontë Parsonage Museum.
