

A People's Mayor: Chris Herd's Call for Kindness in Keighley

If you've ever seen a horse and cart making its way through Keighley's streets, chances are you've spotted Mayor Chris Herd at the reins. Down-to-earth, approachable and deeply proud of his roots, Chris has a way of turning heads, not just because of

Beauty, his gorgeous draught horse, but because of Chris's warm smile and his willingness to stop and talk to anyone. This year, as Mayor of Keighley, he's using that same approachable spirit to bring people together.

At a time when tensions across the country run high over migration policy, economic struggles and global uncertainty, Chris is inviting the town to lean into what it does best: friendliness, pride and community spirit.

"I am a people's Mayor. I want everyone to feel welcome and to get along. Let's be kind and reach out to each other."

Chris lives in Oxenhope, on the family farm. It's a fitting home for someone who believes so strongly in supporting all aspects of country life, including the visitor economy and welcoming people from all over the world who come to walk the cobbled streets of Haworth, ride the Keighley & Worth Valley Railway, or follow in the footsteps of the Brontës.

Alongside his wife Linda, who is Mayoress, business partner and best friend, Chris has built his life around hard work and service. For years the couple ran a thriving butcher's shop in Ingrow, all while keeping

their farming traditions alive. That connection to the land, to animals and to honest trade is part of what grounds him now as he takes on civic duties.

Meeting People Where They Are

Since taking up the mayoral chain, Chris has thrown himself into the role, visiting local schools, voluntary groups and community organisations. Whether it's a remembrance service in the Worth Valley, a fundraiser in the Civic Centre or just a quick hello on North Street, he takes genuine pleasure in meeting people where they are. And if that meeting happens to be over a pint of Keighley's finest Timothy Taylor's beer, all the better. Chris is never one to shy away from a good chat in the pub, where conversations often range from farming and local history to the future of the town.

Standing Up for Two Important Causes

Each year the Mayor selects charities to support, and Chris has chosen two that reflect both compassion and courage. Sue Ryder Manorlands Hospice in Oxenhope, which provides palliative and endof-life care along with bereavement support for families across Keighley, is deeply loved

by the community and depends on fundraising to keep its doors open. Baton of Hope, the UK's largest suicide prevention initiative, is less familiar to many. It is a growing movement working towards a "zero-suicide society". The baton itself tours schools, towns and workplaces, sparking

mental wellbeing and breaking down stigma. By highlighting these causes, Chris is not only raising money but also drawing attention to issues that touch every family at some point in life, caring for loved ones and talking openly about mental health.



opinion. Use green or brown lentils rather than red lentils for this recipe. You will need a fairly deep rectangular baking dish.

classic Lasagne al Forno, in my

Ingredients

For the ragu:

3 tablespoons of olive oil

I medium onion, finely chopped

4 cloves of garlic, finely chopped

I large carrot, finely chopped

I stalk of celery, finely chopped

I tablespoon of tomato purée

225g green or brown lentils, well rinsed

 $1 \times 400g$ tin of tomatoes

750ml water

200g bag of fresh spinach

Juice of I lemon

Salt & black pepper

For the béchamel:

I small onion, roughly chopped

2 cloves of garlic

I bay leaf

½ dozen black peppercorns

Pinch of salt

600ml milk

50g unsalted butter

50g plain flour

150ml double cream

9 sheets of lasagne

Ground nutmeg

3 heaped tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese

Method

First, make your ragu by heating the oil in a large pan, then tip in the onion, garlic, carrot, and celery. Cook gently on a low heat until very soft (20-30 minutes), stirring occasionally.

Once soft, add the tomato purée and stir well to mix for a minute, then tip in your lentils. Stir constantly for a minute to combine, then add the tinned tomatoes and water.

Bring to a very gentle simmer, place a lid on, and leave to simmer for 40 minutes* until the lentils are tender.

Remove the lid, add the spinach and lemon juice, stir to combine, and increase the heat to a steady simmer. Cook until all the surface liquid has boiled off and you are left with a thick sauce, stirring occasionally so the lentils don't stick to the bottom of the pan. Season well with salt and pepper, then set aside.

In a different pan, melt your butter, then add the flour and stir well to combine. Remove from the heat and gradually pour in the milk, whisking constantly. Return to a low heat, add the cream, and cook slowly for 10 minutes.

Preheat your oven to 190°C. Butter your chosen dish and put three sheets of lasagne in the base. Cover with half of the ragu, then a quarter of the béchamel. Next, add three more sheets of lasagne, the remainder of the ragu, another quarter portion of béchamel, then the last three lasagne sheets, and finally the rest of your béchamel.

Sprinkle the top with a generous amount of ground nutmeg, then smother everything with the grated Parmesan. Place on the top shelf of your oven for 45-50 minutes, until the top is golden brown and blistering.

I like to serve this with a plain green salad. *When cooking the lentils, use your own judgement as to how long to cook and how much liquid to use. The times and volume below are a guide, as exact timings depend on the variety and age of your lentils. This recipe serves six people.







Injury Rehabilitation the steps to a successful return to activity. By David Hanson

The most common setback in any training, fitness or healthy lifestyle journey is injury. Whether you are closely following a trusted training plan, ensuing evidence-based advice from the Department of Health, or sticking to strategies that you know improve your mood and mental wellbeing, most of us will suffer the odd injury, especially as we get older.

Getting injured is literally a real pain! Not only does it cause you to miss out on your favourite activities, but it also can cause you discomfort and distress. If you're training for a race or competition, then you'll start to lose your fitness and strength and this further feeds into that feeling of helplessness. Injuries can present themselves in many different ways, but let's focus on one typical injury that may occur when we exercise - a strained or pulled muscle.

Why do we become injured?

Load tolerance is your body's ability to handle physical demands without injury. Two key factors determine it:

- **1.** Load: the physical demand placed on the body. This includes:
- intensity (e.g. force, weight and resistance)
- frequency and duration (how often and how long)
- volume (such as total distance covered or total weight lifted)
- **2.** Tissue capacity: how well can your body's structures (muscles, tendons, bones, ligaments joints, discs, and nerves) cope with these demands.

When the load exerted exceeds the tissues capacity to cope, microtrauma results leading to inflammation, pain and injury.

Taking a break from your activity is the obvious thing to do, and this will generally allow the initial pain and inflammation to settle down. But how long should you rest for and what should you do once most of the pain and swelling has gone and it appears safe to start moving again?

The first 48 - 72 hours

Whilst most people are aware of the R.I.C.E (Rest, Ice, Compression, Elevation) protocol to treat a sprain or strain in the first 2 or 3 days post-injury, it's after this time that people may be unsure of what to do. One thing that I strongly advise against in the first 2 to 3 days after your injury is the application of heat, no matter how soothing this feels at the time. This includes heat lamps, heat creams, spas, jacuzzis and saunas. Applying heat to newly-damaged muscle tissue further increases blood flow to the damaged area and will result in increased bleeding, swelling and pain. One other piece of advice to follow with a new muscle injury is not to stretch the area. Stretching during this early stage of the recovery process just causes more damage ot the already damage tissues.

When is it safe to start back with my activities after a muscle strain?

When a muscle is torn, you would expect that the body would repair the tear with new muscle. In reality, this doesn't happen. The tear is repaired with collagen, more formally know as scar tissue. Collagen is made from a very tough, inflexible fibrous material. This fibrous material binds itself to the damaged muscle fibres to draw the damaged fibres back together.

When scar tissue forms around an injury site, it is never as strong or as flexible as the muscle tissue that it is replacing and you must be careful in this early stage not to overstretch or overload the damaged area. At around 10 days, the scar tissue is strong enough to withstand moderate levels of load safely and it is around this time that you can return to some low level activity that loads the effected area. From here onwards, the scar tissue enters a phase called remodelling where the actual repair of the injured muscle takes place. During this phase is where 'hands on' work from a physiotherapist such as massage and soft tissue mobilisation is very important. This treatment helps to reduce the bulky nature of scar tissue. When we then combine this treatment with an appropriate and progressive rehabilitation programme which targets the injured area in order to regain lost strength, flexibility and function we are fully on the way to a full and lasting recovery.
